


Which side?

Right RA

Left RA

Physician comfort

Less easy for the physician

X-ray exposure

More X-ray exposure

One catheter for both coronary arteries

2 catheters

Less sub-clavian loops

Easier ostia cannulation

RIMA

LIMA

To check palmar arch: Barbeau's test only

EMLA® cream and subcutaneous lidocaine

Left radial more useful, but less comfortable

Fixed wrist with hyperextension

Puncture site: 2-3cm above flexor crease
