

How should I reduce paravalvular leak for my TAVI patients?

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Question 1: Are there any anatomies or clinical situation where the valve is not suitable, or you would prefer a different valve choice?

Currently Navitor is not suitable to treat larger annular anatomies (perimeter over 85mm, area over 573mm2). Also, Navitor has little data for use in bicuspid anatomy and so should be used on an individual basis after heart team review.



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
